Dear Parents and Guardians of Barclay Early Childhood Center:

Our Assisted Student Drop off is going well. If you have more than 1 child in your car during drop off, you are eligible for the Assisted Drop off line. Please call the office for more information. It is our pleasure to help you get your child to school safely. Just a reminder to all parents – please drive slowly through our driveway and parking lot. Be especially cautious when backing out of parking spaces, as there are sometimes other cars or even pedestrians just inches from your cars. Please do not attempt to pass cars that are halted, regardless of whether or not the car is justified in stopping. Patience, please.

I hope you had a rewarding Parent/Teacher Conference. You have received your child's report card during the conference. If you would like to view the report card scales, the entire list is available on our new website. Click on "Our Schools," then "Early Childhood Education," then select Barclay Early Childhood Center. Once on our webpage, you can access the report card scales under the Parent Information Heading. Scroll down to the bottom until you see "Report Card Scales for Each Objective."

As stated during Back to School Night, the new report card has shaded areas which represent the Widely Held Expectations for a child who is either 3 or 4. Your child's report card is automatically adjusted to represent his or her age grouping. If you have any concerns regarding your child's progress or would like additional information about how to help your child progress, please contact your child's teacher or case manager. My door remains open to your questions, concerns, and ideas.
